OCTOBER ROAD REPORT

With the exception of a few days here and there the weather for our mid fall season has been somewhat of a letdown. We had below normal temperatures with much precipitation. In turn, it has affected delays to our road projects and the general fall cleanup.

The beaver baffles have been built and installed on the new Alder Lk. Rd. culvert. So far they have successfully deterred the critter intrusion. But we do need to periodically clean off accumulated "swamp" debris.

The buoys to the lakes have been pulled in along the swim buoys/floats.

All the donated picnic tables and bike racks have once again been removed and put into storage. Along with that all the park's trash cans have also been removed and port-potties shut down.

The Koller Park and the Playground bathrooms have been drained, winterized and shutdown.

The patrol trucks have been outfitted with their winter equipment and are ready for the season.

Something to ponder about for next season, the appropriate signage and road markings for the bike trail.
