The "official" summer season has started once again. Preparations for the 4th's activities have been completed.

A repairing of a "humped" culvert on Alder Lake Rd. was preformed by Kia Asphalt. Upon inspection, it was a very satisfactory job. I would use his services again.

At the Powell (Marsh) Rd. culvert seven beavers have been removed. Little by little we have been removing the beaver created blockage at the culvert.

Started mowing shoulders of the roads towards the end of the month.

Due to the higher elevation of the Community Garden, ground water now back flows and saturates the salt shed staging pad during rains.

On 7/22 at the Cemetery, Minocqua Pest Control sprayed in an effort to eradicate the ant problem.

On 7/24 the Airport Rd. outhouse was torn down to create addition parking.

Something new from the state, we now perform our own salt facilities inspections. It was done and the results have been sent directly to the state.
